I am sorry you are suffering. I will never know or understand your pain and how it has impacted you over all these years.

However, it is only Western Seminary, et al. and their attorneys who have made your name public to harass and target you and it is them who want all of this covered up and have done everything that they can to force it, even if it means having killed me in the process; even if it means having destroyed everything in my life and impacting the lives of others, even if it means damaging many more people in the process.

What Steve did to you, the acts to degrade your life is in the public domain now and has been for years. It stands a testimony to a sociopathic man and his friends who sneer at decency and rail against God, attempting to do anything to cover up what and who Korch really is, including subverting public policy.

Mary R. v. B. & R. Corp., 149 Cal. App. 3d 308 (1983) "The stipulated order of confidentiality is contrary to public policy, contrary to the ideal that full and impartial justice shall be secured in every matter and designed to secrete the evidence in the case from the very public agency charged with the responsibility of policing the medical profession. We believe it clearly improper, even on stipulation of the parties, for the court to issue an order designed not to preserve the integrity and efficiency of the administration of justice (cf. Younger v. Smith (1973) 30 Cal. App.3d 138 [106 Cal. Rptr. 225]), but to subvert public policy by shielding the doctor from governmental investigation designed to protect the public from misconduct within the medical profession, and which may disclose a professional license of this state was used to establish a relationship which subjected a juvenile patient to criminal conduct. Such a stipulation is against public policy, similar to an agreement to conceal judicial proceedings and to obstruct justice. (Maryland C. Co. v. Fidelity, etc. Co. (1925) 71 Cal. App. 492, 499 [236 P. 210].) Moreover, in light of the statutory obligation 317*317 of Division to investigate and regulate the medical profession, a law established for a public reason cannot be waived or circumvented by a private act or agreement. (Covino v. Governing Board (1977) 76 Cal. App.3d 314, 322 [142 Cal. Rptr. 812]; Civ. Code, § 3513; see Bianco v. Superior Court (1968) 265 Cal. App.2d 126, 130-131 [71 Cal. Rptr. 322]; Benane v. Internat. Harvester Co. (1956) 142 Cal.App.2d Supp. 874, 878 [299 P.2d 750].) Accordingly, since such a contract made in violation of established public policy will not be enforced (Bianco v. Superior Court, supra, 265 Cal. App.2d 126, 131), it is improper for the court to sanction the parties' stipulation under the pain of threatened contempt. In light of its over breadth and its intended effect upon the investigation of Division, we strike the order of confidentiality, stressing an enactment designed for the public welfare cannot be abridged by stipulation. (3 Cal. Jur.3d, Agreed Case and Stipulations, § 18, p. 270; see Wilson v. Wilson (1973) 45 Cal. 399, 405.)"

It is a reminder of just how truly evil he and his friends are; how evil some in government are willing to take things. It is a disturbing symptom of the spiritual disease of the religious and their own institutionalized self-destruction.

Just like the damage he intrinsically caused you in 1975, for which no one can ever begin to understand, so is the damage he and many others, including those using public money have intrinsically caused to others in the ongoing effort to cover for the irredeemable demon that is Steve Korch and more broadly Western Seminary.

Steve has harmed and deceived many, many more people than you now, causing life long damage in the process. What Steve did to you and how he and others acted to cover it up is intrinsically and forever related to many people now, including my family, friends, extend family and onlookers.

I personally will never know your pain. But I do know pain and suffering like no other; others have experienced pain

and suffering as a result as well - each different, each demanding. Many lives are now forever altered as a result - the result of one man that never should have been a pastor or teacher; the result of corrupt men willing to mendaciously say anything to cover for Korch and themselves. That is the common theme of those who cross paths with Steve Korch and more broadly Western Seminary.

I can tell you right now, many people are so angry and upset that the mere thought to cover for Korch is like putting more fuel on the fire. Many people have suffered because of Korch.

When I was a kid in school, I read a book titled "The Song" by Calvin Miller. The Song is Calvin Miller's sequel to his book, "The Singer" which is the story of Christ through an allegorical and poetic narrative. Miller has chapter thoughts for each chapter and for one of them, it says "Yes, it was savage for the rifleman to ask the weeping mother which of her sons she would like to have shot first. But the greater cruelty is to ask the frightened child which of his parents he would least prefer to live."

You are suffering and so are others; each differently because the damage is different -- while Korch is at the center. My family, friends, extended family, including myself are not going to go silent about a man who causes so much damage to so many people.

Steve's whole life is bookended with crime and corruption; his whole life has been about covering up who he really is and the intrinsic cost others face. My family, friends, extended family, including myself will not go silent into the night.

The more people know who Korch and more broadly who Western really is, the more people will not be harmed by these sociopathic religious men. This is now about the Church and public welfare, about people routinely deceived by these workers of evil, about charitable donors giving millions of dollars to a corrupt institution - including when they were solicited by Korch.

What Korch did to you is wrong and it will always be very wrong; but Korch did not stop and was not held accountable; which as a result caused life long damage to even more people who are and have been left suffering.
